Applicants must be a senior at any Hawai'i public high school who will be attending an institution of higher education with a declared intended major architecture or other applied, allied or fine arts.

Your piece and 50 word summary should tell us a little about you and how your art embodies the theme "One Part Logic, Two Parts Magic". Artwork can be done in any creative medium: writing, drawing, audio-video, photography, etc.
